



Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

Happy Easter to one and all! Together with Fr. Des Rosiers, Fr. Tim, Deacon Joe and all the staff here at Our Lady Star of the Sea, I wish you and yours a blessed and holy celebration of the Lord's Resurrection.

"He has been raised from the dead, and he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him." This is the Good News of Victory that the angel conveys to the women at the tomb, early in the morning on that first day of the week. The news of Jesus' rising is to be given to his disciples. They are to see him, for he goes before them to Galilee. Matthew emphasizes that Galilee will be the privileged venue of the disciples' encounter with the Risen Lord Jesus. Galilee. The place of their origin. The place of their families. The place of their livelihood. Their home. This is the place where the Victory of Christ Jesus over all sin and even death itself will be made manifest. The gifts that Jesus has bestowed on the believers and, indeed, on the whole world from his cross, are to find their home in our home.

The fulfillment of the Great Commandment of Love that Jesus realized for us on his cross has the power to complete and to perfect the many partial loves of our own lives. Jesus' love gives us the strength and goodness of a love greater than ourselves. Jesus, who was true to his identity as Son of God and Son of Man calls each of us to remain one with him as his brothers and sisters, true children in Jesus of the eternal Father. Jesus, the Word of Life, places his Word in our hearts, allowing each and every word, decision and the very way we manage life's day-to-day responsibilities to become a reflection of his perfect love and, thereby, a source of new and lasting life to all who share our life's journey.

My prayer for you this Easter season is that you, too, will encounter the Risen Lord as did the disciples. They saw him and received a new mission from him in the context of their home, their communities, their work, their daily lives. It is exactly here that the Lord wishes to manifest to you the signs and proofs of his living love. When you seek that love, greater than yourself, as a source of strength to carry on, you will come to know the Lord in his great love for you. When you remain true to your identity as a son or daughter of the heavenly father, you will see the image of the Living One reflected in the substance of who you are and who you are called to be. When you live the Words of the Gospel and manifest them in your daily lives, then will you see and give witness to the power of those same words to heal, to raise up and to transform our fallen world. May the Lord precede you to Galilee (read Marblehead, Swampscott, Salem... Etc.) and may you come to know the surpassing love on the Lord and the power of his new life.

During this coming May, I will schedule opportunities for general Parish meetings, now that our community has truly begun to come alive again after our Covid and other challenges. Together we will look at our pastoral and financial state of health. Together we will set our next priorities for our mission and for the care and strengthening of our families and community.

My thanks to all who have worked so hard to make our Holy Week celebrations the prayerful and fruitful moments of prayer that they have been. I am especially thankful for those many in our music ministries and all those who have read, distributed communion, served, cleaned, steamed, hung, typed, ran, folded, designed, prayed, pressed and prepared in any way. May we rejoice together in our desire to make manifest in the world the presence of the Risen One in our midst.



Comments from Deacon Joe Caster

I always point out that Easter lasts for the fifty days of Eastertide. This isn't just my personal opinion. St. Athanasius calls the fifty days one "great Sunday." The octave of Easter, the week from Easter to next Sunday, is the high point of the celebration, with each weekday having the rank of a solemnity. Why not pop in to daily Mass and celebrate with the rest of the worldwide community? It would not be amiss to wish people "Happy Easter"* all week, but even if you can't quite be that "different," at least keep it in mind that it's Easter. If you have decorations, keep them up. If you have special foods, continue to enjoy them as long as you can.

It is said that every Sunday Mass celebrates
Easter — Jesus' triumph over sin and death. Now is
the celebration which we recall every Sunday.
*Our greeting is "Happy Easter," but the Greeks, and
possibly other Eastern peoples say "Christos anesti,"
"Christ is risen!" which focuses on the reason for our joy.


