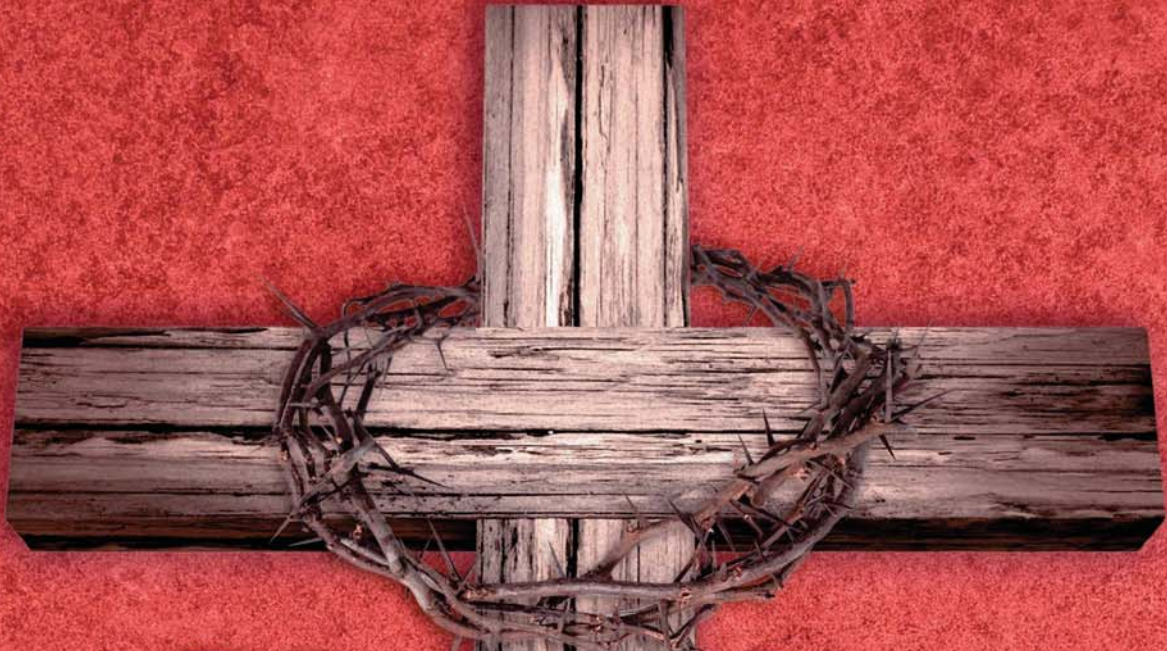

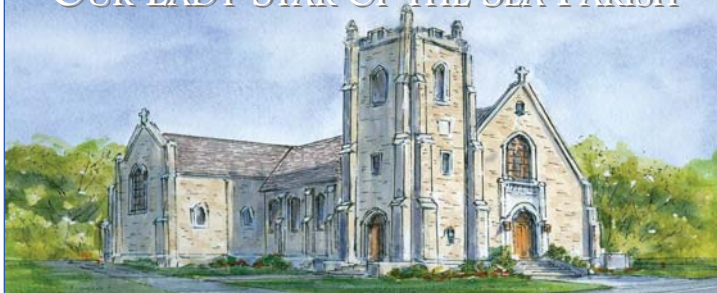

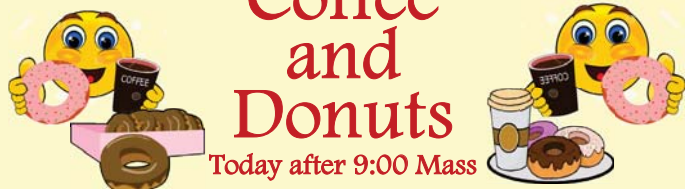

Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

Holy Week is here. We, as a Church, are in the midst of celebrating a Jubilee of Hope. This Holy Week, we pray for the strength of our Church community and for success in bringing the Gospel, our hope for new life, to the world. This hope is not an expression of our own wants, needs or desires as if we were saying: "I hope that I can..." It is, rather, an apprehension, a grasp of the good that God has done for us in Christ Jesus and our conviction that we can live a better life in light of that gift of grace we have received. Such a hope does not disappoint.

Indeed, it is the Lord's invitation to take up our cross and to follow him that guides our celebration of this Holy Week. Today we recall Jesus' triumphal entry into the Holy City of Jerusalem. We relive the story of the passion and death of the Lord Jesus. We walk in the steps of the Lord's final earthly hours, asking for the renewal of his guidance and his grace in our lives. We experience, yes, the desolation of Mary, Jesus' mother, and of the faithful few as they consign Jesus' body to the grave. We hear from St. Luke, this year, the wonderful promise of Jesus from the height of his cross: "Amen, I say to you, today you will be with me in Paradise." Because of this promise to the Good Thief and to us, we await in hope the joy to come in the victory of God's tender mercy for the fallen world as we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus on the Third Day.

You are invited to make the events of Holy Week part of your own spiritual journey. Join us for the Day of the Lord's Passion beginning on the night of Holy Thursday with the Mass of the Lord's Supper. We recall the gift of the *Eucharist* given by Jesus the night before his death. We commemorate the gift of his *Priesthood* which he bestowed on the Church as he commanded us to "do this" in his memory. We re-dedicate ourselves in his grace to the works of *charity and service* for our brothers and sisters as we recall the wonder of God's free gift of love to us manifest in Jesus. The Church remains open for Eucharistic Adoration until midnight. Later on this same day of the Passion, we gather Good Friday at Noon and at 3:00 in the afternoon as we join in the Stations of the Cross devotion with the Church world-wide. At 7:30 p.m., we remember with somber joy the wonder of Jesus' love as we commemorate the *death of Jesus* on the Cross. On Holy Saturday the Church sits lost at the tomb of Jesus, contemplating the dead silence of what life would be like in this world without Jesus, who frees us from the slavery of sin. In the night leading to the "Third Day" (for us the Vigil at 8:00 p.m. Saturday evening) our prayer erupts in joy as we proclaim the *Resurrection of the Lord Jesus*.

The collection on Easter Sunday is taken up for the Clergy Fund Trust, for the support of the retirement and health needs of our elderly priests. Please be generous in your support of this effort, remembering, perhaps, priests who have helped or inspired you over the years.

The schedule for the Easter Triduum is in this Bulletin and has been mailed to all our households. Please keep it for reference during these days. Opportunities for Sacramental Confessions are also included. I pray that you will make the decision to participate in the ceremonies of Holy Week. They will be a kind of spiritual retreat in which you will draw closer to Christ as we contemplate his tender love and the hope that love gives. That is, after all, the real celebration of Easter, the new life we have in Jesus!

Asking God's blessing on you, your loved ones and our Parish community for a worthy celebration of Holy Week, I am

The CREATION CARE CORNER

The Team is pleased to partner with Black Earth Compost, Marblehead's and the Parish's composting service provider, and Sustainable Marblehead, for a **community wide presentation on composting**. It will be held on **Earth Day, Tuesday, April 22**, at 7pm in the Hall at the Parish Center.

Composting all types of food scraps, including fruits, vegetables, meat, bones, shells, and dairy products, along with compostable service ware is a great way to reduce waste, reuse food scraps, and return nutrients to local soils. It helps to reduce the amount of curbside trash and lessens the amount of food scraps put down the disposal and into local water treatment plants.

Black Earth also collects hard to recycle materials such as electronics, textiles and plastics.

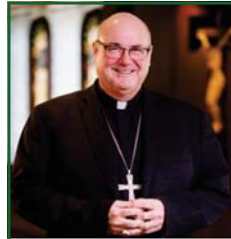

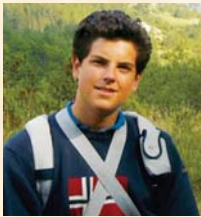

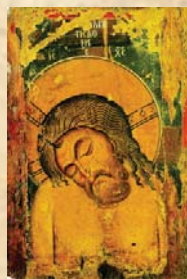

Comments from Deacon Joe

Palm Sunday



Holy Week begins today with Palm Sunday. One feature of the week is the four Songs of the Suffering Servant of the Lord which are found in the Book of Isaiah. (Isaiah 42:1-7; 49:1-6; 50:4-9a; and 52:13 - 53:12) The first three are read at Mass on the first three weekdays of the week, and the fourth, which most explicitly foreshadows the

sufferings of Jesus, on Good Friday. We also hear the third on Palm Sunday. There are several levels of meaning in them. At some points Isaiah seems to be speaking of himself. At some points he seems to be speaking of the people of Israel, whom God has said will be a light to the nations. We see a more complete fulfillment of these prophecies in the preaching and above all in the sufferings and death of Jesus which lead to his resurrection and bring us salvation. Now the Church, the Body of Christ, continues the work of the Lord as the light of the world in the midst of the sufferings and persecutions we must endure in the world until at the end of time we share in his victory. If you can't be at the Masses on Monday through Wednesday and at the Good Friday liturgy, it could be very worthwhile to meditate on them prayerfully at home.

The Sacred Triduum begins with the evening Mass on Holy Thursday and continues through Easter. Ever since Pope Pius XII revised the Holy Week liturgies in the 1950's, (https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Liturgical_reforms_of_Pope_Pius_XII) these liturgies are capable of engaging our minds and spirits in a way that leads to a deeper level of understanding and ap-

preciation of the saving work of Jesus which we celebrate at every Mass. This deeper understanding and appreciation can, in turn, lead us to a deeper faith and a deeper attachment to Our Lord. I encourage you to attend all three evenings if possible, or as many as you can.

Catholic Update this month is by the Archbishop of Santa Fe, John C. Wester. It is titled "Living in the Light of Christ's Peace: An Archbishop's Call for Nuclear Disarmament." Perhaps some people will tend to dismiss the idea and not bother to read it, but I think that would be a mistake. Note, by the way, that he is not calling for unilateral disarmament by our country. I have personally felt that the United States is justified in maintaining a nuclear deterrent, but the archbishop makes points which we should think about. Conditions today are not the same as 70 years ago, when only the U.S., the USSR, England, and France had nuclear weapons. Now more countries have them and others such as Iran seek to develop them, creating an increased danger that a rogue regime may use them or that there will be an accidental launch. We should also remember that throughout the Old Testament, God calls Israel not to rely on military strength and superpower alliances but on him for their security. So there are serious questions for us to consider in the light of our faith and in the light of world history and current conditions. We won't necessarily all come to the same conclusions. Please read and ponder.

As part of your almsgiving, don't forget the Archdiocesan Catholic Appeal. It funds the good works of the Archdiocese that we belong to.
