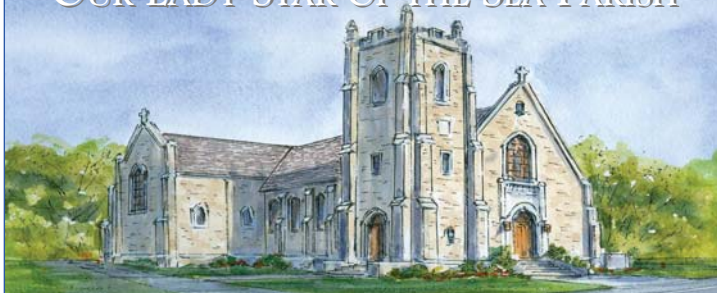

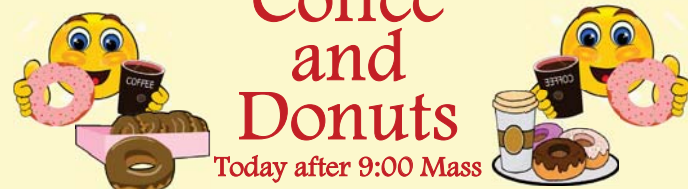

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

"Happy Easter! We gather for our Easter celebrations during this Jubilee Year, 2025, proclaiming a "Hope That Does Not Disappoint." We pray for the grace to rise with Jesus and, thereby, rise to the challenge to bring life, hope and effective love to realization in our midst.

Our Easter readings introduce us to the women of Easter, striving to do the good, to realize some mercy in the face of a terrible loss. "While they were puzzling over this." How puzzling to find the word "puzzling" so featured for our celebration of Easter. Yet this is just how St. Luke (see Luke 24:1-12) presents the scene "at daybreak on the first day of the week." As the women "puzzle," two men appear in shining clothes. Luke would have us think of Elijah and Moses who had appeared with Jesus in just such array on the mount of transfiguration. The two resplendent men say to the women: "Remember what he said to you." St. Luke assures us: "and they remembered His words."

Puzzled by the givens of life's cruel realities and unable to find "the Living One" among the dead of the cemetery where they stood, the women encounter the reality of Jesus' resurrection "remembering" his Word. This Easter remembering is no mere look to the past, dusting off old cobwebs to review once known and now lost realities. No. This Easter remembering is the living grace to see the whole world anew in the light of Jesus, the Word of God, now risen from the grave. The whole of creation is "re-membered." Our former life is given, as it were, new heart, new mind, new hands and feet, new members. Jesus, as they would soon experience firsthand, has been raised to new and splendid life. And their life, too, is being changed, being transformed, being transfigured. They are immediately drawn into a new communion of life and purpose as, without any explicit command, they "announce" the good news to all the others. The followers of Christ are drawn into a new life by the Risen Lord, becoming living "members" of his glorified body, living hands and feet sent into the world to announce the Lord's Victory over sin and death.

You and I are oft "puzzlers." Ours is a time, too, of many disappointments, violence and conflict in society and in our world. So many of our brothers and sisters are caught in the mill that grinds life down between competing visions and means and ways. So much of trust, relationship and community is unfairly disrupted, dismembered. They share the Lord's passion; we must not be indifferent. We try to make sense of the givens of life that, so often, just don't add up on their own. Easter invites us to be drawn to the Living One, to Jesus, Risen from the grave. In the light of his Word, in the light of our living friendship with him, we encounter Our Lord who "re-members" our life experience, puts the pieces together and puts us together with others of his company for a new purpose and a new mission of life. Rise with Christ to new life and remember his Word in all you say and do! In this, unlike others of our time, we do not look to force or constrain the other, we do not return hate for hate, anger for anger or hurt for hurt. We are called, with Jesus, to give hope and to bring change to this fallen world. That can be accomplished only by those willing to walk Jesus' ways, remember his word and to be his hope before any and all manifestations of evil.

On behalf of Father Stephen, Deacons Joe and Kris and all the staff of our Parish I offer our prayerful best wishes for a wonderful Easter celebration. Special thanks go the ministers, musicians and all who work to help our Parish pray well the mysteries of the Lord's dying and rising to New Life! Thanks, too, to the High School Youth Group members who assisted in our Easter celebrations.

The Team is pleased to partner with Black Earth Compost, Marblehead's and the Parish's composting service provider, and Sustainable Marblehead, for a **community wide presentation on composting**. It will be held on **Earth Day, Tuesday, April 22**, at 7pm in the Hall at the Parish Center.

Composting all types of food scraps, including fruits, vegetables, meat, bones, shells, and dairy products, along with compostable service ware is a great way to reduce waste, reuse food scraps, and return nutrients to local soils. It helps to reduce the amount of curbside trash and lessens the amount of food scraps put down the disposal and into local water treatment plants.

Black Earth also collects hard to recycle materials such as electronics, textiles and plastics.

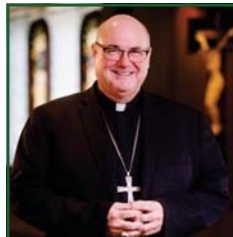
## Attention Flower Lovers

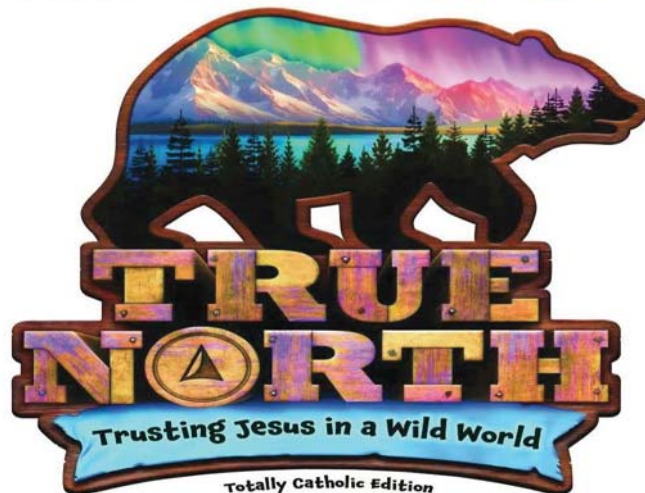
## EASTER MESSAGE FROM ARCHBISHOP HENNING

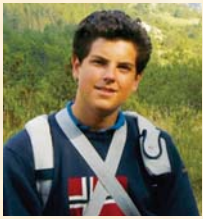

### Comments from Deacon Joe

#### *Christ is Risen!*

**He is truly risen!** Our celebration of Easter continues for fifty days, a week of weeks. So the first week of Eastertide is like the first day of that “week of weeks”. The Church treats these days liturgically as if they were almost a single day. We don’t have a tradition of Easter parties, like Christmas parties, but it wouldn’t be a bad idea to do so. More importantly, let’s do what we can to keep it in our minds that we’re celebrating Easter until June 8. Sunday Mass will help us. The vestments will be white, and the readings will all be from the New Testament, rather than starting with one from the Old Testament. A reading from the Acts of the Apostles gives us an account from the life of the Church after Jesus’ resurrection and ascension. Then a reading from the Book of Revelation gives a vision of events in heaven. Finally there is an excerpt from the Gospel of John reminding us of the words and ministry of Jesus. Daily Mass, especially during this first week of Eastertide, would enhance your celebration. Maybe we



could also try to greet each other by saying “Happy Easter” during this week. At any rate, for us this is the most joyous time of the whole year. Whatever happens in daily life, the important thing to remember is that Jesus has conquered sin and death for us.

**When I was growing up** Easter was one of the three feast days when the extended family would gather for dinner. It was usually, if not always, a ham baked with cloves and canned pineapple slices, accompanied with mashed potatoes and I forget what all else — maybe green beans and other vegetable(s), probably my grandmother’s apple pie. Of course, those days are long gone, and I may have a slice of ham one day of the week. I know lamb is traditional for many people, and I often have lamb in some form during the week, since the whole week “counts” as a prolongation of the Sunday. Nowadays, friends invite me to join them on Easter Sunday, for which I’m very grateful. I hope you will be able to mark the day with some element of celebration, whatever old or new form it takes — with family, friends, or even alone.



**This week** no celebrations take precedence over the weekdays of the Octave of Easter.
