

December 3, 2023 First Sunday of Advent

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

"Be watchful and alert! You do not know when the time will come." Indeed, the time has come, rather suddenly. Advent is here!

Our Christmas Fair has been a wonderful occasion this weekend as we make our transition towards the celebrations of Christmas. I hope you and your loved ones had a wonderful day and took the opportunity to join the festivities. We will be drawing this Sunday morning the winners of our Christmas Raffle. Good luck to all who have taken part. My deepest thanks to all who have contributed to the Fair, especially to members of our planning committee. We will have an opportunity for complete thank-you acknowledgements in next week's Bulletin.

The time has now come for us to begin a new Year of Grace, that of 2024. With this First Sunday of Advent, we begin anew our cycle of prayer, of Gospel reading and meditation and our weekly renewal in the life, death and resurrection of the Lord, Jesus. The Gospel Reading cited above (see Mark 13:33-37) tells us that we, the servants, have been put in "charge." The Lord has entrusted to us all of the blessings of life and love for which we should be thankful each day. What precious gifts has God put into our hands! Be alert, then. Be Watchful! Take great care to cherish and increase all that the Lord has brought your way.

But more follows. God has also given into our hands, our charge, the gift of his very own life and love confided to us in the Lord Jesus Christ. As St. Paul points out (see 1 Corinthians 1:3-9) "for the grace of God bestowed on you in Christ Jesus, that in him you were enriched in every way." We who are barely worthy of the natural gifts given to us have also been entrusted with the Gospel, the Word made flesh in Jesus Christ, with God's loving plan of salvation for the entire world. It has been entrusted to you. What are you doing with these divine gifts? Are you watchful, alert, engaged? Are you bringing the full power of these wonderful gifts to bear on your life and that of the world?

As we look at the world, and the violence, oppression and dangers that abound, we very much know how urgently we need and desire the Lord to "come." The Prophet Isaiah once voiced with great heart at a time of precariousness for God's people, begging the Lord to return, to come to our help and aid: "Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, with the mountains quaking before you, while you wrought awe-some deeds we could not hope for, such as they had not heard of from of old" (see Isaiah 63:6b-17, 19b, 64:2-7). Our world needs more than ever the faithful presence and strength of God in faithful and strong witnesses to God in this world. You are that person. Be strong; be alert, be watchful for the goodness of God that alone can set us right.

As we begin our new year of prayer together, we ask for the grace to recognize the power of the gifts of word and sacrament we receive at God's altar. Let us ask for the grace to let that love received powerfully transform our lives and, though us, the lives of all around us.

Asking God's blessing on you and your loved ones for this new Year of Grace, I am

Comments from Deacon Joe

Advent Arrives

We have arrived at the beginning of Advent, the weeks leading up to Christmas. The season begins on the fourth Sunday before Christmas. This year the Sunday before Christmas is December 24, and the preceding Sundays are December 3, 10, and 17. This means that Advent this year is as short as it can possibly be: three weeks and one day. During Advent we focus on the coming of the Lord. At the beginning we consider his coming at the end of time to bring God's kingdom to its fulfillment. As we get closer to Christmas Day, our attention turns more to Jesus' coming to earth at his birth in Bethlehem. Throughout Advent, we also recall that Jesus comes to us in the Mass.

Christmas Decorations I have thought of myself as a "purist" when it comes to Christmas decorations. My idea has been that Advent isn't the celebration of Christmas. Christmastide runs from Christmas to Epiphany, and that is when we should have our Christmas decorations. At most, perhaps, we might decorate a week before Christmas. I thought of it as an example of an American tendency to celebrate holidays before they arrive rather than waiting for the day itself and then basking in the afterglow.

But my view has been challenged during a recent trip along the Rhine. On Saturday, November 18, workers at a site we visited were removing pumpkins and putting up Christmas decorations. The next day in Strasbourg, the booths for the Christmas fair were already filling the square in front of the cathedral. And so it was in every city we visited, large or small. They were preparing for the fair, which would start on December 3

or earlier. So I have to admit that there is at least some justification for decorating before December 18. But I still think that Christmas should bring us to a higher level of festivity. I'll also continue to suggest that Christmas parties should be in the time following Christmas — although that may be a lost cause. At any rate, we should not think that on December 26 Christmas is over. During Advent our idea should be, "Christmas is coming." Then on and after December 25 we say, "Christmas is here!"

This week December 8 is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In her Immaculate Conception, Mary is the patron

saint of the United States, and the day is a holyday of obligation. Masses in our parish will be at 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. https://

December 7 is the Memorial of St. Ambrose, bishop of Milan and one of the great doctors of the Church https://www.britannica.com/biography/ Saint-Ambrose/Evaluations-andinterpretations.

Finally, although it is only an optional memorial, we might note that December 6 is when we commemorate St. Nicholas, a bishop whose generosity has caused him the morph into Santa Claus https://www.britannica.com/biography/Saint-Nicholas.
