February 4, 2024 Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

"All this I do for the sake of the gospel, so that I too may have a share in it." St Paul speaks of his share in the mission of the Gospel to the world (see 1 Cor 9:16-19,22-23). The Good News of Jesus Christ says that we encounter and embrace ultimate things, things of God's goodness, his truth and beauty, in every aspect of life, even in moments of difficulty or suffering. Our share in the mission takes on new purpose and finds its destiny in the love and goodness of God come to the world especially to those among us who suffer the most.

Jesus, speaking of himself and of our communion of mind and heart in him (see Mark 1:29-39), tells his disciples: "For this purpose have I come" to bring the Good News of the Kingdom to every town and village. So he went forth preaching, healing and casting out demons throughout Galilee. We have, in Christ, the opportunity to know something of God's presence, goodness and love and to share it with all we meet. Like Jesus, we are called to draw close to those who suffer. Aware of that surpassing love of God and our mission to it, we find that life is much hard work, significant sacrifice, too, but unending joy. Such is the lot of all who walk in Jesus' way.

Those who do not yet recognize or truly welcome God's purpose over them find, instead, the drudgery of days spent in service of passing things and losing gains. In the back of our collective mind, we who bear the human condition echo the gloomy question posed by Job in the First Reading (see Job 7:1~4, 6~7). "Job spoke, saying: is not man's life on earth a drudgery?" With all the wonders and accomplishments of which we are capable, so often things turn down and get worse, making the heart believe that life is a drudgery, is unfair and unrelenting. There are so many souls, bravely facing the demands of life's daily responsibilities who find themselves depleted, dejected, forgotten or unfulfilled. So much drudgery there!

You and I are called by Jesus to visit such "villages" of mind and heart. We are to fulfill our "purpose" of bringing Good News, new perspective and the saving ways of Christ to hearts who very much need to hear the Word. If you have found hope and purpose in Christ, never hesitate to bring it as your gift to others. It will be the one thing that makes all else coalesce for them, raising them up in the goodness and love of God. What a gift! What a way of life bringing such gifts to others!

During the month of February, our Parish takes the lead responsibility for furnishing the Marblehead Food Pantry with its needed supplies. Shopping bags are available at the doors of the Church as reminders and guides towards making a contribution to our efforts. Your assistance is a great way to realize a practical expression of love for your brothers and sisters in need as you help lift the drudgery of recurring need and give a sign of hope that things can change for the better. Volunteers are still needed to help bring donated items from the Church to the Parish Center after each weekend mass this month of February and to sort and date the items after the 11 o'clock mass in preparation for their distribution. Comments from Deacon Joe

Lent

In the early centuries of the Church. Easter became the time when the bishop would baptize and confirm the cate~ chumens at the Vigil

Mass. He would also reconcile those who had separated themselves from the Church through grave sins. There were special prayers for the catechumens as well as "scrutinies" to be sure they were ready to undertake the obligations of living a Christian life. Penitents would do public penance, notably lying prostrate at the door of the cathedral at Mass times. As time went on, ordinary people came to regard this Lenten season as a time for them also to prepare for the Easter celebration. The three practices Jesus mentions in Chapter 6 of the Gospel of Matthew prayer, fasting, and almsgiving — were seen as worthy of intensified attention during Lent.

We offer additional opportunities for the Sacrament of Reconciliation during Lent — a sacrament for reconciliation both with God and with the Church, which is wounded by our sins. We can pray more intensely by attending daily Mass, or if that is not possible, by meditating on the scripture readings for each day. You can find them in "The Word among Have a good week. Us" which is available in the church. Of course you can choose any form of prayer which suits you. Similarly, beyond the restrictions that apply to Ash Wednesday and Fridays, you can choose any sort of fasting — giving up something — which is meaningful for you. Almsgiving can take the form of donations to any worthy charity.
