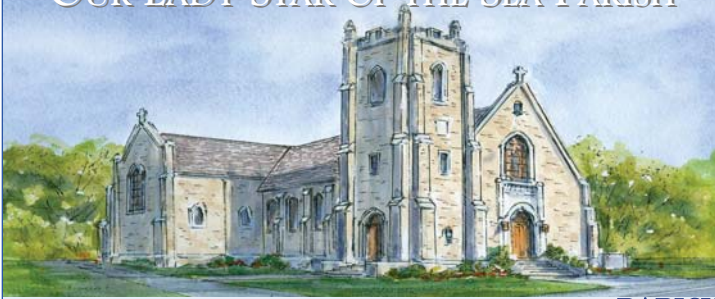

# OUR LADY STAR OF THE SEA PARISH

Marblehead, Massachusetts

February 9, 2025  
Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

*Duc in altum!* Set out for the depths! (see Luke 5:1-11). Twenty-five years ago, this command of the Lord to Peter recounted in today's Gospel was used by Pope John Paul II as his theme for the opening of this Twenty-first Century, a challenge of Jesus to us all. A quarter century later, our current Jubilee of Hope invites us to assess how well our excursion into the depths is truly going.

"Put out into deep water..." And how deep this water is! We first hear Isaiah: "I am doomed! For I am a man of unclean lips!" (see Is 6:1-2a,3-8). We then hear Paul: "I am... not fit to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the Church of God" (see 1Cor 15:3-8,11). We hear, too, Peter: "Depart from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man" (see Luke 5:1-11). From the point of view of guilt, harsh judgment, limitation and failure these three appear to be drowning fast. And there are waves. In this period there has been a falloff of Catholic participation and fervor. We have seen a widening abandonment of Christianity in our Western democracies. Our societies, even local, opt instead for a rather pagan approach to life. It is accompanied by increased violence, by recourse to war and by further fragmentation of family life and a coarser, promiscuous attitude to human sexuality and intimacy. Each of us, too, is well aware of our own fault and failings, even serious ones, that mark and sadden our hearts and memories.

We are out in the deep water, and it is a scary proposition. For Peter, Jesus' challenge initially meant heading further from shore where he would receive the next command: lower the nets for a catch. In hope for the efficacy of Jesus' word, Peter did. The results were, for him, overwhelmingly good. The "deep water" to which we are called is not a place of fear nor of a realm of things we are not able to understand. It is a realm where hope is realized. The "depths" to which Christ calls us is the realization that everything in our everyday life is replete with the signs of God's never failing love. We, like Peter who lowered nets in his everyday work, are to fulfill the daily responsibilities that fall to us, realizing that we deal with a greater depth of meaning than others may see. When we do our work at the Lord's command we realize a depth and a return that is overwhelming, that is measured by the extent of God's own life and love. In the beautiful words of the Seraphim conveyed to us by the Prophet Isaiah (see Is 6:1-8), we pray each Mass that both "heaven and earth are filled with his glory." They ask us to see and to serve that greater depth, teaming with life, that exists in everyday circumstance, thanks to the love of our heavenly Father. Earth is "full" of the glory of God just as surely as is heaven. Do you believe this? Does the spirit of hope with which you approach the lowering of your nets in everyday life recognize the great things God seeks to accomplish in and through your efforts?

The word of Christ's Gospel invites you to say yes, and to follow Christ, discovering there the full meaning of this world, the full truth of your identity and the full extent of your mission to bring Christ's love to all you meet. Today, for example, is also the World Marriage Day, promoted by the Marriage Encounter movement. Only the person truly aware of the truth of one's own life can be clear that the goodness and love in life is there to be had not from oneself but from God. Such a person can truly give of his or her life in love and in a Godly freedom for the benefit and good of the beloved. Only one who knows who one is in the light of God's mercy recognizes and honors the presence of God in the beloved. All of the graces to which Isaiah, Paul and Peter were called are also graces to be discovered and lived in our marriages and in our homes and in our lives. May God bless us in this way.

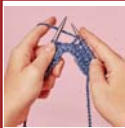

## The CREATION CARE CORNER BLACK PLASTICS



Black plastics, largely as single-use packing and trays for food, occasion questions concerning toxic and flame retardant chemicals therein that may leach into food during cooking. Often, recycling centers cannot accept these items because of sorting issues, so they end in landfills, with possible damage.

### Consider these suggestions:

- \* Replace any black utensils, like spatulas and soup spoons, with those made of wood or stainless steel.
- \* Avoid microwaving black plastic containers or trays.
- \* Switch any food you purchase in black plastic to glass, ceramic or metal storage containers.
- \* When ordering takeout food or drink, request non plastic packaging, leaving black plastic utensils, stirrers or straws behind. Use instead your own non plastic utensils and cutlery from home.
- \* Purchase a cup of coffee-to-go using your own ceramic or metal coffee mug rather than single use hot cups especially those with black plastic sippy lids.

### What to do with remaining items?

MacRae's Sustainable Goods in Marblehead, in collaboration with Plastic Recycled, may be able to recycle/repurpose black plastic into cool products such as benches and chairs.

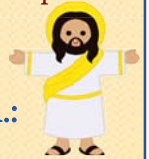

## Comments from Deacon Joe

### Sports / Sunday Mass

An article in the February issue of "America" delves

into the place of sports, especially youth sports, in Christians' lives. The author is clear and emphatic on the point that sports are good. He laments, however, that nowadays they have largely lost the aspect of "play" which was the point of unstructured games that used to be

commonplace for children. He notes that our Sundays should include worship (Mass), play, and rest and that sports should not crowd out the other two. That means, we shouldn't allow sports to make Mass attendance or simple relaxation impossible. Nor should we see sports as purely utilitarian: a means for getting into a good college, itself seen as a means to a lucrative career. Rather, sports should be seen and participated in as an element of the full human development of the participant. These thoughts are more fully developed and there are additional insights, so I recommend reading the full article <https://www.americamagazine.org/faith/2025/01/13/youth-sports-catholic-rest-249675>.

**World Day of the Sick** In 1992 Pope St. John Paul II designated February 11, the (optional) Memorial of our Lady of Lourdes, as World Day of the Sick. He encouraged us to use the day to offer our sufferings "for the good of the Church," whatever those sufferings may be. Further, the day reminds us to see in the sick an image of Jesus, who suffered and died for our sake, and then rose, achieving our salvation. Of course, we should also pray for the healing of all who are ill in body, mind, or spirit.



**World Marriage Day is today**, the Sunday before St. Valentine's Day. Congratulations to all married couples. Let's pray for their happiness as well as for those who are being called to the vocation of married life.



**This week** the Memorial of St. Scholastica, O.S.B., is February 10. She was the twin sister of St. Benedict, and became a nun. She and her brother remained close while living their religious vocations <https://www.franciscanmedia.org/saint-of-the-day/saint-scholastica/>.

February 14 is the Memorial of Sts. Cyril, monk, and Methodius, bishop. They were brothers who lived in the 800's and worked together as "Apostles to the Slavs" of several nations. They are patron saints of a number of slavic countries, and John Paul II designated them as co-patrons of Europe together with several other saints [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Cyril\\_and\\_Methodius](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Cyril_and_Methodius).



What about St. Valentine's Day? When the Roman liturgical calendar was revised in the 1960's, the revisers decided that the memorial of Cyril and Methodius was more important for the Church's witness to the world than that of St. Valentine. So Valentine no longer has an official memorial day in the liturgy, but he is still recognized as a saint, as is the case with hundreds of other saints who don't have memorials in the General Roman Calendar.
