Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

“The Kingdom of Heaven is like a treasure... like a pearl of great price... like a net thrown into the sea.” In our Sunday readings, we are in the third of five great “discourses” by Jesus as presented in Matthew’s Gospel (see Mt 13:44-52). This section describes the Kingdom, not as a place, but as a set of relationships: right relationship with God; right relationship with one another in God. It was preceded by the Sermon on the Mount in which Jesus described the *way of life* of the Kingdom and the discourse on Discipleship in which Jesus told of the aims, demands and rewards of *sharing* the Kingdom. The importance and place of God’s love in our lives are based on the “Blessed” life described in the Sermon on the Mount that you and I, as Disciples, are called to proclaim with the substance of our lives.

We see from the parables of today’s three images, each taken from the main occupations of the people to whom the Lord was speaking. Treasures in the field were the dream of any local farmer. A pearl commanding a great price was the measure of success for any town merchant. Nets full of catch are the hope of each and every fisherman plying the waters of the local sea. With these familiar parables about the Kingdom, today’s passage speaks not so much about the articles of treasure, of a truly valuable pearl or of a netful of take. Rather, it speaks about the need of each person to recognize what is truly of value and to commit wholeheartedly to its attainment. Each story, then, speaks about a sense of deep joy in finding and securing what is really worthwhile in our relationship with God and with one another in God.

Each story insists that action is needed: “they sell... they buy... they haul it ashore and sit down to put what is good into buckets. What is bad they throw away.” In the end, the parables say, it is the angels of God who are sent out to sort. God’s Word, then, will reveal who among us have perceived and secured what are the real treasures of life. God’s Word points to the difference between the righteous, who have gone for the things of God, from the wicked, who have tied themselves to a passing world and its ways. Leave, then, what is of less value aside. Secure what is truly a treasure and a pearl. Sort the good and the bad aspects of life with confidence and constancy.

You and I are called to new life in God and to new love in our relationships with one another in God. Begin to exercise that attitude of a “wise and understanding heart” exemplified in the first reading through the figure of Solomon (see 1 Kings 3:5, 7-12). Begin to live by the underlying optimism of St. Paul (see Romans 8:28-30), who faithfully proclaims “all things work for good for those who love God.”

Reaching the end of July this week, we remind ourselves that the Fall is swiftly approaching. There is work to do. I have been delayed in the preparation of our Parish Financial Report which is so necessary to help us assess and manage our "treasure" for mission. Parish Council is completing work on a set of by-laws to organize their work and to foster wider participation in decisions. We will shortly communicate with families for plans for religious education that will be of good quality, flexible and fully responsive to the challenges life brings our way every day. I look forward to introduce new leadership in Parish faith formation come September. Confirmation Candidates who have completed all other requirements should *call* to schedule an interview. Again, in charity, extend this reminder to friends and family!

The Catholic Climate Covenant has honored the Creation Care Team at Our Lady Star of the Sea Parish, Marblehead, in the first U.S. *Laudato Si'* Champions Awards in the parish category.

Named after Pope Francis' landmark encyclical on care for creation, the *Laudato Si'* Champions Awards celebrates individuals and organizations doing transformative work on *Laudato Si'* issues in the United States. The Catholic Climate Covenant bestowed 10 special awards to outstanding Catholic individual, family/couple, diocese, parish, school, university, religious community, business, health care and organization showing real commitment to the Platform's seven *Laudato Si'* goals.

Our Parish Team was selected by Covenant staff. According to the Catholic Climate Covenant: "Among your accomplishments, we were especially impressed by your actions in educating and mobilizing your Parish on *Laudato Si'*."

On July 27, the Creation Care Team's honorable mention was recognized publicly via Zoom at an 8:00 to 9:30 p.m. session, which was also the capstone to the 2023 *Laudato Si'* and the U.S. Catholic Church Conference, co-sponsored by Catholic Climate Covenant and Creighton University.

"On behalf of Creighton University and Covenant staff and all of our supporters, thank you for your commitment to God's creation, your fellow humans, and all creatures. You are an inspiration!" read an email from Covenant.

Elaine Leahy, Coordinator of our Creation Care Team, responded to the news saying: "All Parishioners have played a role when they have donated items to the refugees, use the compost bin, pick up litter and generally support the ministry, so it is an honor for all of us at Our Lady Star of the Sea."

We thank the Catholic Climate Covenant for this wonderful honor. We thank especially the members of the Creation Care Team who help our community embrace the teachings of *Laudato Si'*. May we focus on continually improving our efforts.

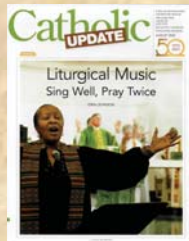
## Comments from Deacon Joe

### Heat Wave?

**Meteorologists define** a heat wave as three successive days with a high temperature of 90° or above. Writing this column on Wednesday, July 25, I see predictions of highs over 90 on Thursday and Friday, which would not be an official heat wave. By the time you read this, we'll know if Saturday gave us a third, but even if it's only two days over 90, we still had a chance to enjoy summer heat. Of course, it's wise to have plans for keeping cool when it's that hot. The cellar is often the coolest area of the house, so that's a good place to spend time. Opening windows at night to let the cooler night air in (aided by window fans if possible) is widely recommended.

**Catholic Update** for August is available. It's titled "Liturgical Music: Sing Well, Pray Twice" with the subtitle based on a saying of St.

Augustine. It gives an overview of music in liturgy over the Church's history, describes various kinds of things that can be sung, and invites us to think seriously about we do sing and ought to sing at Mass.



**This week** there are three obligatory memorials, two of priests and one of a bishop.

July 31 is the Memorial of **St. Ignatius of Loyola, S.J.**, the founder of the Society of Jesus (Jesuits). He was born in the Basque region of Spain in 1481 and died in Rome on July 31, 1556. Convalescing from

wounds received in battle, he read lives of Christ and the saints and was converted to a life focused on God. With Francis Xavier and Peter Faber, he founded the Jesuit order in 1539. Its principal works are teaching and missionary work. For a number of years Jesuit priests served here as weekend assistants. I recall Frs. Paul Mankowski, Ron Anderson, Joseph O'Keefe and Robert Keane [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/ignatius\\_of\\_loyola](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/ignatius_of_loyola).

**On August 1** we celebrate the Memorial of **St. Alphonsus Liguori, C.S.S.R.**, founder of the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer (Redemptorists) and Doctor of the Church. Born in September, 1696, he died on August 1, 1787, and was canonized in 1839. The Redemptorists' principal work has been giving parish missions. They also produce Catholic Update through their apostolate Liguori Publications. St. Alphonsus has been recognized by the church as a great moral theologian, rejecting the rigorism of the Jansenists while avoiding laxity [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Alphonsus\\_Liguori](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Alphonsus_Liguori).

The Memorial of **St. John Vianney** (the Curé of Ars)



is August 4. A French diocesan priest, he became famous for his devotion to hearing confessions, attracting thousands of pilgrims from many countries. He was born in May, 1786, and died August 4, 1859. He is the patron saint of diocesan priests.
