

Kids are also welcome to come and help, and lend their artistic talents to color the bags or write notes.



Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

In our own day, relativism is a hot-button issue. For some, relativism in the culture is a measure of freedom, in which each and every person is able to decide each and every thing's moral and civic worth and standing, with no necessary tie to any overarching truth or duty. The only exception, for many of them, is the absolute submission to and recitation of politically correct dicta as conveyed from time to time from the "influencers" whose names, aims, or games no one person is ever allowed to know. They are relativists, but tie nothing to nothing but themselves. For others, relativism in the culture is the measure of its demise, the ultimate undoing of every moral and civic duty and bond of obligation by which any society maintains worth and good standing. Relativism's denial of any truth beyond "my" truth or society's "interests" of the moment is seen by some as a final break with past foundations leaving all in free-flux that leads nowhere. They are anti-relativists, but relate everything to everything and define each person and circumstance by its bond to what is already known and possessed.

Oddly, today's readings call us to a kind of relativism, but differently from either of the above thought patterns. The Lord Jesus invites his followers to become "rich in what matters to God" (see Luke 12:13-21). To the one brother who demands that the other brother be made to "share the inheritance," Jesus relativizes the claim, refuses to be the judge or arbitrator and calls for a greater freedom from possessive attachments or claims of any kind. He then points out the folly of the rich man and his bountiful harvest who, thinking only of his own rest, food, drink and merriment, fails to perceive that he has become possessed by his own possessions and ends up neither happy, nor free, nor satisfied, nor alive. These three well display what the First Reading lamented about life: "Vanity of vanities! All things are vanity!" (see Ecclesiastes 1:2; 2:21-23). One wants more and is unhappy unless he can make his brother give more; one has more but is unwilling to share with a brother who wants; yet a third has more than he can deal with but wants ever more for himself, though it is killing him.

Rather, as echoed by St. Paul in the Second Reading (see Colossians 3:1-5,9-11), we strive to "think of what is above, not of what is on earth" so that we might be "put on the new self, which is being renewed, for knowledge, in the image of its creator." Becoming rich in what matters to God is a form of relativism to which the Gospel calls us. It is the way in which we relate the persons and circumstances of our life to God's love that counts. It is the way we actively "treasure" the things of the spirit that makes all the difference. Nothing has value on its own. Such isolations are empty vanity. Each reality in our life finds value on the way that we are relativized, taken up and transformed each day in the power of that surpassing love that makes us truly free. The Gospel works that wonder in us when we are rich in what matters to God by sharing the strengths of Godly love with our brothers and sisters.

We celebrated this week Vacation Bible School with a group of our youngsters, assisted by teens and adults. The theme was Monumental: the Greatness of Faith in God. I am so grateful for the many who assisted and for the opportunity had to learn, play, praise and pray. All of this is aimed at gaining the perspective of Faith in the never-failing love of God over us and over our lives.

## Comments from Deacon Joe *Cooling Off*

As I write this for the Wednesday deadline, the weather is a little cooler and drier than the previous days of heat wave. Looking at a bigger picture, we know that the end of July and beginning of August are usually the hottest days of the year. In other words, from here on we can expect gradually cooling weather until winter's freezing days. It's not a prospect I enjoy, since I much prefer summer to winter. Even though I must admit, grudgingly, that there are usually some beautiful days in fall, my general view is that things will be going in the wrong direction overall. So I want to appreciate the real summer weather as long as it lasts.

Vacation Bible School seems to be going well. The children are learning about who God is by seeing how he worked in the life of Joseph, who was sold as a slave in Egypt and was able to save the country and his own family from a severe famine.

This week the big feast is on Saturday, *The Transfiguration of the Lord*, celebrating the event when Jesus' appearance became bright and radiant and Moses and Elijah appeared alongside him. God the Father proclaimed, as he had done at Jesus' baptism, that Jesus is his beloved son. There are several aspects to this event: Jesus' divinity, the unity of Old and New Testaments, a glimpse of the future resurrection — both Jesus' and ours. The Eastern Churches had long celebrated this feast. It was in 1457 that Pope Callistus put into the Roman calendar because it was the day Rome learned that a Turkish invasion of Europe had been stopped at Belgrade. It is a benefit of Msgr. Moran's decision to have Mass on Saturday mornings that we can join in the celebration of this great feast of the Lord. We also celebrate the Memorial of St. Alphonsus Liguori on Monday, August 1. St. Alphonsus lived from 1696 to 1797. He founded the Redemptorist Order (C.S.S.R.) to give missions, especially to the rural poor. <https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Redemptorists> The Mission Church in Boston was founded and is still staffed by Redemptorists; and St. John Neumann, bishop of Philadelphia was a Redemptorist.



St. Alphonsus Liguori

Among St. Alphonsus' many gifts, perhaps his greatest was in the area of moral theology, on which he wrote extensively. He was canonized in 1839 and proclaimed a Doctor of the Church in 1871. [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Alphonsus\\_Liguori](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Alphonsus_Liguori) Thursday, August 4, is the Memorial of St. John Vianney, "the Curé of Ars," patron saint of parish priests. Ars was the remote village in France to which he was sent. In his zeal for the people of his parish, he preached clearly and heard confessions for long hours. His reputation spread, and large numbers of penitents came to Ars. He died in 1859 and was canonized in 1925. 
