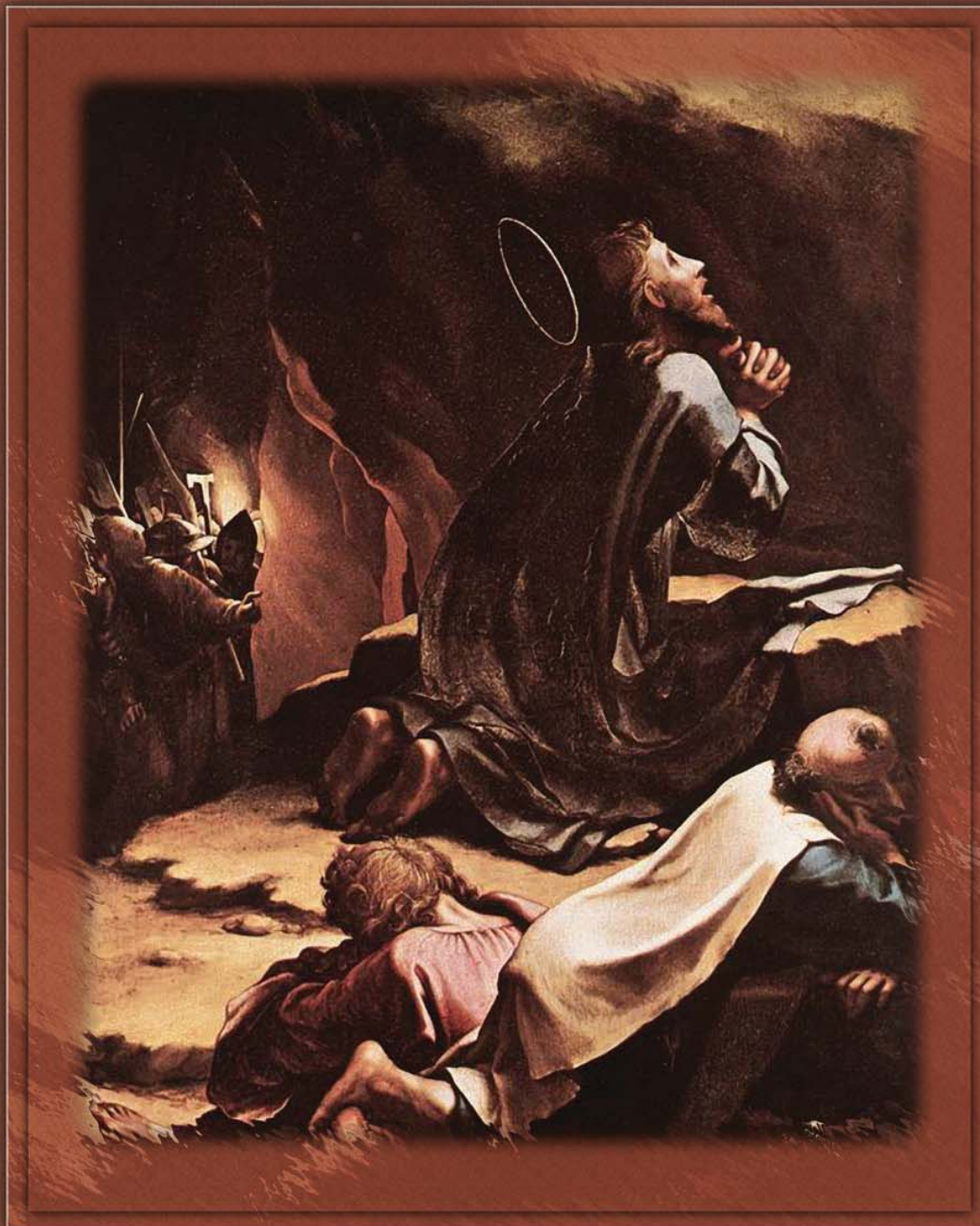

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

Our prayers focus this weekend on Jesus and that moment of the cross, his "hour" in which he would be "lifted up from the earth" and draw everyone to himself. March 17th is also St. Patrick's Day, Patron of our Archdiocese of Boston, and one who drew many to the love of Jesus. We remember the needs of our local Church community in our prayers. We are asked, too, to indicate our response to the Annual Catholic Appeal which helps enable the various ministries and services that our Archbishop and our diocese offer. The purpose of our efforts is to make the Lord Jesus better known and loved, moving forward in faith. I pray that we will be generous in our support, needed as it is. After the 9:00 Mass, everyone is invited to share beverages, Irish Bread, other goodies, song and fun in honor of St. Patrick at the Parish Center.

The Lord says his "hour" has come. The word for "hour" can also mean "now." St. John anticipates for us the mystery of Jesus' "hour" of glorification on his cross. We make that mystery our own, now, by allowing Jesus to truly "draw" us to himself. Our celebration of Holy Week is aimed at helping us to say "yes" to Jesus' call. In response to the Lord's desire to draw you to himself, make it a priority this year to pray the whole of the paschal mystery with our community.

Next Sunday we begin Holy Week with the commemoration of the Lord's triumphal entry into Jerusalem and with the praying of the Passion of Our Lord according to Mark. We will mark together the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Thursday night, the opening of the First Day of the Passion. We will watch and pray with the Lord through the night joining his prayer in Gethsemane for "one hour" as he asked. We lovingly commemorate his death for us on the cross as the rest of Good Friday unfolds. The Second Day is that of the Lord's lying in the tomb. We wait Saturday in Sabbath quiet with the women of his company who saw where he was buried. Only having walked the way of his cross with Jesus will we be ready to be one with him in celebrating his Resurrection on the Third Day beginning in the night at the Easter Vigil. The full victory he has won for us over all sin and death will awaken in our hearts. Be there with us in this journey of faith and renewal, remembering what was done, celebrating its impact in our life now and preparing with Jesus for our drawing others to his new Kingdom of life and love.

Tuesday is the Solemnity of St. Joseph. Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. Our prayer will include the Blessing of St. Joseph's Table. This devotion asks us to join in sharing our gifts with those in greater need. We will bless and distribute the "Zeppoli of St. Joseph," asking God's grace to help us share our joys more generously each day.

The best preparation for your celebration of the Lord's Death and Resurrection is through a good confession. Please see extra confession times listed in the Bulletin, including a Penance Service Wednesday of Holy Week, March 27th, from 7 to 8 pm.

Comments from Deacon Joe

St. Patrick's Day

It's the Fifth Sunday of Lent and the Mass today is of the Sunday, not of St. Patrick. The parish is having our traditional Irish soda bread with butter and marmalade after the 9:00 Mass, with musical entertainment provided by Matt Arnold. We can all keep our St. Patrick's Day traditions (corned beef and cabbage, anyone?) in honor of the patron saint of the Archdiocese of Boston. He is also patron of Nigeria, among many others. He is considered the Apostle of Ireland, and was a tireless missionary, traveling all over the island. Few facts are known for certain about Patrick's life, but what is known, together with abundant legends, testify to his missionary effectiveness https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Saint_Patrick.



encourages us with the expectation of warmer weather. In the words of W.S. Gilbert, "The flowers that bloom in the spring (tra la)/ Breathe promise of merry sunshine." Unfortunately, the cold ocean water keeps us cooler than areas several miles back from the coast. In summer, though, most of us will welcome the sea breezes.

This week, in addition to the Solemnity of St. Joseph, there are two commemorations possible. March 18 is the Commemoration of St. Cyril of Jerusalem. Born around 313, Cyril became bishop of Jerusalem about 350 and died in 386. He was exiled three times due to his opposition to Arianism. His important writings include the Catechetical Instructions explaining the faith to those preparing for baptism and the Mystagogical Catecheses, an explanation of the sacraments for the newly baptized. In 1883 Pope Leo XIII declared him a Doctor of the Church https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Cyril_of_Jerusalem.



St. Joseph's Day On Tuesday, March 19, we celebrate the Solemnity of St. Joseph. As with St. Patrick, we have very little biographical information about St. Joseph. What we know comes from the gospels, which tell us he was the husband of the Virgin Mary, a descendant of King David, and a just man who heeded revelations from God which he received in dreams. He cared well for Jesus and Mary. Official devotion to St. Joseph grew slowly, beginning around the year 800 and culminating with Pope Pius IX's proclaiming him as Patron of the Universal Church. In our church he is depicted at the top of the window of the prophet Jeremiah. He is shown above St. Peter's Basilica with the title Universal Protector https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Saint_Joseph.



Saturday, March 23, is the Commemoration of St Turibius of Mogrovejo, who lived from 1538 to March 23, 1606. After he had taught law at Salamanca, King Philip II of Spain appointed him Grand Inquisitor of the court at Granada in 1571. The king later nominated him to be Archbishop of Lima, Peru. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1578 and to the episcopate in 1580. He was zealous in implementing the decrees of the Council of Trent and in preaching the gospel, baptizing perhaps 500,000 people, including Sts. Rose of Lima, Martin de Porres, and Francis Solano. In 1983 Pope St. John Paul II proclaimed him patron saint of the bishops of Latin America https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Turibius_of_Mogrovejo.
