

March 30, 2025 *Lætare* Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

Rejoice! We rejoice at this midpoint of our Lenten journey because we look forward to the great feast of Easter: our reconciliation with God and with all our brothers and sisters: life anew! "The old things have passed away; behold, new things have come. And all this is from God..." These words of St. Paul (see 2 Corinthians 5:17-21) come to us as he speaks of the "ministry of reconciliation" that God has given to us, his Church. Rejoice! You are to be an "Ambassador," bringing the joyful message of God's reconciliation to the whole world. Our world needs this message of forgiveness and renewal more than ever.

Our Gospel passage (see Luke 15:1-3, 11-32) is the wonderful story we often call the "Prodigal Son" or the "Merciful Father." The Parable is addressed to Pharisees and Scribes who would not sit down to feast with Jesus because of their judgment against the "sinners" who were in the company of the Lord. The Parable addresses how one might come to share rejoicing in the Great Feast of Reconciliation and New Life we call Easter.

We see, in the figure of the Father, a man able to rejoice in the true demands of relationship and love. True relationship is the one reality that can relieve the profound sense of unworthiness that has smothered the life of the younger son as well as the deep, bitter anger that arrests the heart of the elder son. We are invited to the Father's celebration.

The younger son, though still burdened by his past selfish actions, resolves to return to the Father. Even though his motives are self-serving, when he arrives he is welcomed to enter a feast beyond all his expectations. It began as a journey of "imperfect" contrition, but it puts him into the realm of victory over death and the abundance of new life.

The burning burden of anger of the elder son, however, is a deeper problem. It keeps that son outside the celebration, outside of his father's joy. His share in our fallen nature makes him not only unforgiving of his brother but of his father as well. He has lived as a slave to rules his whole life long, finding no joy and unable to forgive. He is unable to enter the feast. Without the gift of forgiveness, there is no entering new life.

The newness of life offered by God's reconciling love is the one reality in which we can see our true worth and by which the bitter angers that can accumulate over the years can be finally set aside. We celebrate that new life in prayer. Our Lenten Thursday night Praise and Worship followed by Adoration is a way to deepen our hunger for a new way. Friday evening we have the Stations of the Cross at 7:00. The honors fall to the Readers who proclaim God's joyful Word to us each week. Come share their joy in this commemoration of the Lord's Via Dolorosa. We follow closely, intentionally, in the footsteps of the One by whose love we find peace, coming alive beyond ourselves in union of mind and heart with the Lord.



The Exhibition will open during our Thursday Eucharistic Exposition on May 8th



Gender dysphoria is a complex topic within the wider appreciation of gender identity and that of personal identity. We all seek to understand such realities more fully. While some general principles have been enunciated, it is clear that when individuals experience gender dysphoria, each situation is a separate case and that dysphoria can be experienced over a wide spectrum of intensity.
