

May 21, 2023 Seventh Sunday of Easter

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

Veni Sancte Spiritus! Come Holy Spirit! In this period of nine days from the Ascension to Pentecost we join the Church in her heartfelt prayer. The First Reading (see Acts 1:12-14) is a description of us, the Church in every age: apostles, disciples, men and women together, brothers and sisters of the Lord gathered with Mother Mary in our midst. In such a wise are you called to be the best hope of our human family as we journey forward to our ultimate destiny before God. United in prayer with Mary, Star of the Sea, you and I reach out in good works for the betterment of the life of others. In communion of mind and heart, we join the Lord in God's own work of his New Creation. We join the Lord as he brings new life to this fallen world.

Because of this prayerful communion of mind and heart with each other and with Jesus, we can, in St. Peter's words (see 1 Peter 4:12~16) "rejoice exultantly" together in Christ. Even facing the inevitable difficulties of rejection, misunderstanding or insult that may be ours in the world, everything in life can be welcomed for it serves to invite from our hearts an always deeper trust in Jesus' saving love.

"Now this is eternal life, that they should know you, the only true God, and the one you sent, Jesus Christ." The Gospel of John (see John 17:1-11a) portrays Jesus as sharing this summary of his teaching as he concludes the Last Supper with an extended prayer. Eternal Life is to know God's love revealed in Jesus and made real in our lives through the gifts of his Word and his Sacraments. Being raised up on the cross, Jesus "glorifies" the Father by showing forth how far the saving love of the Father is ready to reach out, to forgive and to raise us up. Being raised up on the cross, Jesus, too, is glorified, showing forth for the first time the real love and trust in which our human family is to cherish God. Through his death and resurrection Jesus fulfills perfectly the "Greatest Commandment" of love of God and love of neighbor. He saves us in the power of that love. Belonging entirely to Jesus who belongs entirely to his Father, our life, too, becomes a gift. It is a gift of joy, strength and new life for our neighbors whom we should love just as Christ loved them. In such a love we are drawn together as Church. May we "come to know" the one true God and Jesus Christ whom he has sent! May the world come to know him through us.

Jesus, in today's Gospel, says: "I pray for them." We know that the Lord included us in his prayer that day and forever. He counted us as his own, God's greatest gift to him. We continue that loving care of the Lord as we lift up before God the lives and futures of those among us who are graduating college and graduate schools in these days and, soon, our own High School Graduates. They are a true gift in our midst and we ask God to give them joy as they face the next phases of their lives' journeying and their service for the good of all.

I am completing plans for general Parish meetings to be held in the coming weeks. Together we will look at our pastoral and financial state of health. Together will set our next priorities for our mission and for the care and strengthening of our families and community. Together we place our trust in the Lord.

Renewing our prayer with the Church for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon us for the sake of the world, I am

Comments from Deacon Joe Last Week of Eastertide

This is the last week of Eastertide so if you have some element of your celebration of Easter still to be done, you'd better get cracking.

"Holiday Season" I like to call the period from Ascension Thursday to the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul (June 29) our holiday season. The feasts can come closer together if Easter and Pentecost come a bit later, but we have in fairly short order Ascension Thursday, May 18, Pentecost, May 28, Trinity Sunday, June 4, Corpus Christi, June 11, Sacred Heart, June 16, St. John the Baptist, June 24, and Sts. Peter and Paul, June 29. That's seven solemnities in six weeks. We have a lot to celebrate.

This week we have one obligatory memorial and five optional memorials, three of them on the same day. May 22 is the optional memorial of St. Rita of Cascia. When her husband was murdered, she urged her family not to take the usual revenge. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Rita_of_Cascia May 25 has three optional memorials: St. Bede the Venerable, O.Ś.B. an English monk and historian who died in 735 https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Bede; Pope St. Gregory VII, O.S.B., who fostered reform in the church and promoted the church's independence from secular rulers https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Pope_Gregory_VII; and St. Mary Magdalene de' Pazzi, a Carmelite mystic. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Mary Magdalene de%27 Pazzi The next day, May 26, gives us the only obligatory memorial of the week, that of St. Philip Neri, founder of the Congregation of the Oratory. He was noted for his cheerful spirituality, which makes him a good model. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Philip Neri Finally, on May 27 we have the optional memorial of St. Augustine of Canterbury, O.S.B., head of a band of monks sent by Pope St. Gregory I in 595 to evangelize the Anglo-Saxons. 
