First Holy Communion Retreat Last Saturday

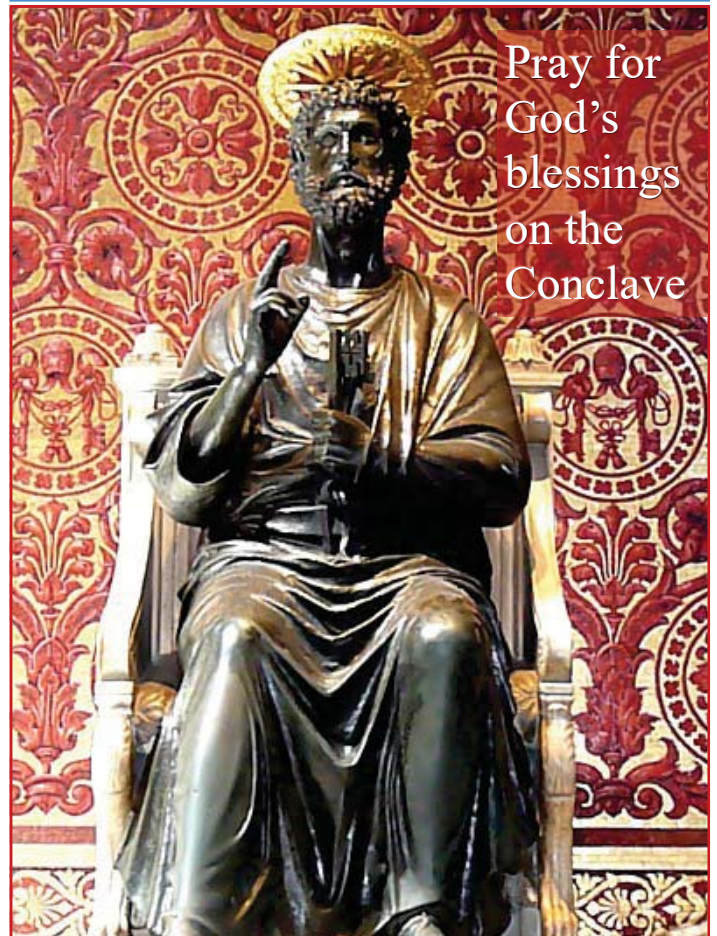
The Retreat morning for our Candidates was this past Saturday. We are grateful for the many parents who planned and led the morning for the children.

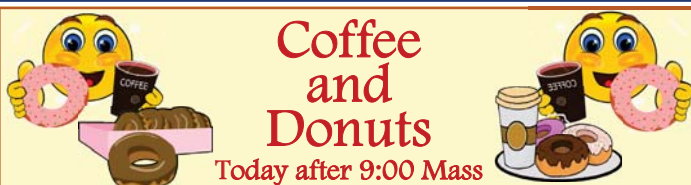
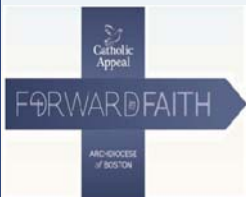

Third Sunday of Easter

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

“Follow Me.” This is the Easter invitation of Jesus to Saint Peter. It is Jesus' invitation to his Church and to us individually. Peter, who in his fear and weakness denied knowing the Lord, is asked thrice to profess his newfound love. That love, like our own for the Lord, is to be made manifest in sharing that same love, forgiveness and new life to others. It has a more poignant call for us as we gather praying for the soul of Pope Francis and of praying for the work of the Conclave soon to begin. This Easter Gospel scene focuses on the two images of mission and outreach: be a fisher for people; be a shepherd for their sake.

The miraculous catch of fish that the Apostles realize when they follow the word of Jesus is brought together by a “net” that “was not torn.” The net that Jesus offers us is the gift of his mercy. It recalls the unity of our Church community. We are to cast mercy forth into the relationships and situations that we encounter each and every day. That mercy has the power to bring in the catch and not to fail, not to tear until God’s will is accomplished in and through us.

Similarly, Peter is sent forth as a shepherd ‘to feed, to tend, and to feed’ those Jesus calls “his” lambs, his sheep. Shepherding the very love that Jesus has for his own, reflecting upon it, reflecting its own power in our own words and actions is the way we can tend to, strengthen and protect those whom God entrusts to us in life.

As we complete today nine days of prayer for Pope Francis, we can rejoice in remembering his call to mercy in our outreach to others and the clear highlight he made on that mercy in his ministry. We are grateful for the years of service as a shepherd, not only of the Church but also those on the peripheries of life the world over. We pray, too, for those entering the Conclave on Wednesday and upon their work of discernment. No better criteria are there than that of one who has heard the call of the Lord to “follow me” as did Peter, and one who knows that he loves the Lord and is ready to witness to that love by making a gift of his life in its service.

We celebrate Easter best when we employ the mercy of God generously in our relationships and in our lives. We celebrate Easter best when we perceive Jesus’ own love for his own, appreciate that love and reflect it in our own words and actions in others’ regard. May the New Life of Easter continue to grow strong in our midst. May we give glory to the risen Christ by being the instruments by which God’s mercy and love are made real in our world today.

Next weekend, we celebrate First Communion with a number of our youngsters on Saturday. What a celebration of new life will it be! We pray for the candidates that their love for the Lord will be strengthened and that they will remain close to him all the days of their lives.

On next Sunday, after the 9:00 morning mass, there will be a May Procession led by our First Communicants. You are all welcome to take part as we honor our Blessed Mother Mary and pray for our mothers living and deceased on Mothers' Day.

## The CREATION CARE CORNER

The Team partnered with Black Earth Compost, Marblehead's and the Parish's composting service provider, and Sustainable Marblehead, for a **community wide presentation on composting** held on **Earth Day, Tuesday, April 22**. Peter Fallon of the Creation Care Team spoke of the passing of Pope Francis and the importance of his leadership in environmental affairs through his encyclical *Laudato Si*. Ongoing inspiration and commitment will be a fine way to honor his service and sense of mission.

Discussed were composting of all types of food scraps, including fruits, vegetables, meat, bones, shells, and dairy products, along with compostable service ware as a great way to reduce waste, reuse food scraps, and return nutrients to local soils. It helps to reduce the amount of curbside trash and lessens the amount of food scraps put down the disposal and into local water treatment plants.

Black Earth also collects hard to recycle materials such as electronics, textiles and plastics.

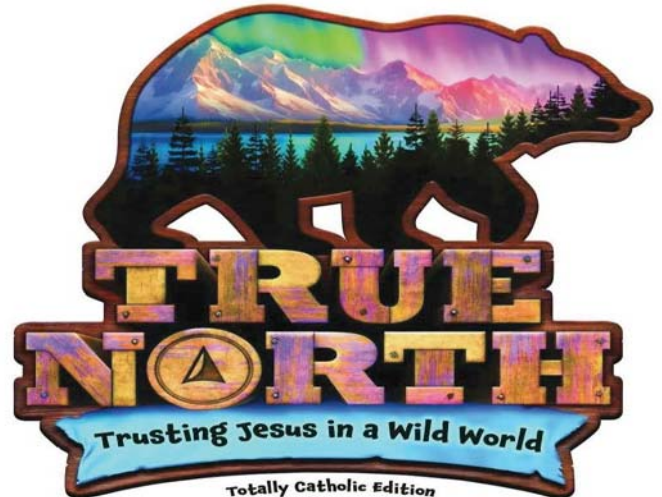


## Volunteer(s) for Cookies!

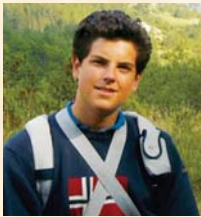

## Comments from Deacon Joe

### What are you giving up for Fridays?

**Here's some background** and discussion about Fridays as days of penance. In their statement relaxing the obligation to abstain of Fridays <https://www.usccb.org/prayer-and-worship/liturgical-year-and-calendar/len/US-bishops-pastoral-statement-on-penance-and-abstinence> the US bishops say, "Sacred Scriptures declare our guilt to be universal; hence the universal obligation to that repentance which Peter, in his sermon on Pentecost, declared necessary for the forgiveness of sin (Acts 2:38). Hence, too, the Church's constant recognition that all the faithful are required by divine law to do penance." They also point out that "Catholic peoples from time immemorial have set apart Friday for special penitential observance by which they gladly suffer with Christ that they may one day be glorified with Him." Although they strongly recommend abstinence from meat, the bishops also note alternatives such as "self-discipline in the use of stimulants and ... a renewed emphasis on the virtue of temperance, especially in the use of alcoholic beverages" and the performance of good works in a spirit of penance.

Nowadays, with extensive vegetarianism and veganism, it may be easier to find meatless meals than it was fifty years ago, but it doesn't mean that they are things meat eaters enjoy as much as meals that include meat. For non-meat-eaters, finding a suitable alternate Friday penance could present a challenge. Perhaps one way all of us can approach it is by asking ourselves what we give up for Lent and giving it up for Fridays as well.



**Town Meeting** begins on Monday, May 5. The Conclave begins on Wednesday, May 7. We can't vote in the conclave; we can pray that the Holy Spirit will guide the cardinal electors. But all registered voters can attend Town Meeting at 7:00 p.m. at the Middle School and vote on the future of our Town.

**This week** there are no solemnities, feasts, or obligatory memorials. On Saturday, May 10, there are two optional memorials. St. John of Avila, a zealous missionary in Spain, a mystic and author who died in 1569, was canonized by Paul VI in 1970. Pope Benedict XVI declared him a Doctor of the Church, and Pope Francis added his optional memorial to the general calendar in 2021 [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/John\\_of\\_Avila](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/John_of_Avila). Better known in this country is St. Damien de Veuster, who ministered for years to the lepers of Moloka'i, eventually contracting the disease and dying from it in 1889 at the age of 49 [https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Father\\_Damien](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Father_Damien).
