Thirty-first Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

“The greatest among you must be your servant.” This familiar saying from the Gospel (see Matthew 23:1-12) comes at the end of St. Matthew's presentation of the Lord's public life and ministry. It is Holy Week. Jesus begins his teachings about the end times. The tensions have built and Jesus has answered the various tests and traps set against him by his opponents. He now calls his followers, and Christians of every age, to a particular view of life and leadership to be seen and heard in our words and actions each day. Chief among the themes we hear in this regard is that we, in order to be “great” in the things of God, should place ourselves at the service of our brothers and sisters. There is much to be learned and to be imitated in this regard. We are to avoid the faithless self-service denounced in the First Reading (see Malachi 1:14b-2:2b, 8-10) and we are to keep God our Father's ways and keep faith with one another. When all is said and done, we seek to be like Christ who came among us not to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many. For this reason St. Paul describes his service to the Thessalonians (see 1 Thes. 2:7b-9, 13) as that of a gentle nursing mother, as one of true affection and sharing.

Where do you find the presence of God in your lives? He is found as the one who serves. Jesus is in our midst as the One who serves the good in our lives. God himself has entered our life in a role of loving, saving help. Jesus invites his followers and his opponents to recognize what is before their eyes: he is the “greatest,” he is God, right there standing before them. Jesus is God's love incarnate, serving and bringing about their salvation. That is why the prophet described God as exclaiming: “A great King am I, says the Lord of hosts!” Those who serve the true good in our lives are truly “great” if they reflect for us the presence of the “greatest” among us, Jesus Christ. Therefore, each of our words and all of our ways find their greatest importance in their relationship to God. We recognize that our words and deeds are to be, as St. Paul pointed out, not just a human word, but realities that point to Jesus, to Jesus' Way, to the great “Word of God, which is at work in you who believe.”

During the month of November, we remember in a special way our beloved who have died. All Souls' Evening, we had a special mass for parish family members who died in the past twelve months. Before the Statue of St. Joseph, Patron of a Happy Death, there is a register in which you may inscribe the names of recently departed for whom you ask our prayers. If you have already inscribed names in the book, they need not be repeated. All the names will be remembered in prayer for the entire month.

An urgent need for service to neighbor exists with regard to our Marblehead Food Pantry. Donations in recent weeks have been down and the supply of food has run low. This is particularly worrying as we draw closer to the holidays. An appeal is made for you to be of help and to include with your weekly shopping some item or other to be donated to the Pantry, especially boxed or canned goods, sugar, flour and other staple kitchen supplies (small packaging) or paper goods.

Plans are well underway for the Christmas Fair. December 2nd is the date, and I hope you have the Fair marked on your family calendar. A mailing with Raffle information goes out this week. The Raffle gives you the opportunity to win outstanding prizes donated by our own local business and parish members. Great gifts on offer, fine food to share as well as delectables to take along will highlight the day. The Living Nativity scene will be part of our celebration again this year.

Comments from Deacon Joe

Congratulation to Those Being Confirmed



Today several of our parishioners are receiving the Sacrament of Confirmation. Now they will be able to serve as sponsors at baptism (godparents). More importantly, they will receive an outpouring of the Holy Spirit to assist them in living out the vocation to holiness which they share with all Christians and to live their own personal vocation within the community of the faithful for the spreading of the Kingdom of God through all they say and do. All of us who have been confirmed should remember that we too have the gifts of the Holy Spirit to show us God's will for us and help us fulfill it.

Veterans Day I am very pleased with the way Marblehead has maintained its traditions of observing civic holidays, especially Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Veterans Day. The Veterans Day ceremony is usually held at 10:00 a.m. on November 11 in Abbot Hall Auditorium. (Check the newspapers to verify the date and time.) It is well worth attending.

This week we celebrate the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica, also known as the Basilica of St. John Lateran. It is the cathedral of Rome, and the adjacent Lateran Palace was the pope's residence until the Vatican Palace became the papal residence 14th Century. In the 15th Century, the current Apostolic Palace adjacent to St. Peter's Basilica was built, and popes took up residence there; but the Lateran Basilica (rebuilt and renovated over the centuries) has remained the cathedral of Rome. As such, it can be considered the mother church of Catholics. The original cathedral was built on land which had belonged to the Laterani

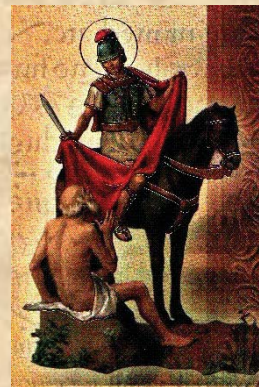


family of ancient Rome. The Emperor Constantine gave the site to the pope in the early 300's and the first basilica and palace were dedicated by Pope Sylvester I on November 9, 324 https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Archbasilica_of_Saint_John_Lateran.

The Memorial of Pope St. Leo the Great, Doctor of the Church, is November 10. He was born into an aristocratic family in Tuscany around the year 400 and after serving as a trusted ambassador and deacon for several years was elected pope in 440. During his papacy he had to deal with several heresies and turned Attila the Hun away from Rome in 452. His

"Tome" on the divine and human natures of Christ was adopted by the Council of Chalcedon as the correct expression of doctrine on that question, and he wrote many sermons and letters which survive. He died on November 10, 461 https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Pope_Leo_I.

On November 11 we celebrate the Memorial of St. Martin of Tours, a soldier who became Christian at the age of 18. He was zealous for the orthodox faith but opposed the killing of heretics. The most famous story about him is that as a soldier he met an ill clad beggar and gave him half of his military cloak. That evening he had a vision of Christ wearing that half of the cloak. In 371 he became bishop of Tours, and he died in 397 https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Martin_of_Tours.
