

Comments from Deacon Joe

Farewell to Summer

The autumn equinox will be this Saturday, September 23, at 2:50 a.m. So that morning we'll wake up to fall. At least it's not winter, so I shouldn't complain, for now.

Oktoberfest in Munich begins this weekend and runs through the first weekend of October. This year it extends through October 3, German Unity Day. I've never been to Okto-

berfest, and I don't particularly want to go, but I like the fact that it's been going on for over 200 years of good spirits, and maybe I'll have some bratwurst to celebrate along with the Bavarians and others who visit from around the world https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Oktoberfest.

This week the biggest weekday celebration is on



Thursday the 21st, the Feast of St. Matthew the Apostle and Evangelist. As we remember, he was a tax collector. As such, he was working for the Romans; he was one of a group of people who were considered disloyal to Israel and so disloyal to God. Some people complained that Jesus ate "with tax collectors and

sinners," the sort of people the "righteous" would want no contact with. When Jesus called Matthew to be his disciple, he showed clearly that God definitely did want contact with such people. No matter how much we have sinned, God wants us to come and follow him. He'll help us turn from sin, no matter how long it takes. And no matter how bad we think other people are, God wants them to follow him, too, so he can help them turn from their sins no matter how

long it takes https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Matthew-the-Apostle.

Wednesday, September 20, is the Memorial of the

martyrs Sts. Andrew Kim Taegon, Paul Chong Ha-sang, and Companions. Altogether 103 individuals were canonized by Pope St. John Paul II on May 6, 1984. They were



martyred during successive waves of persecution in Korea between 1791 and 1866. In addition to these heroic witnesses whose names we have, it is estimated that there were another 8,000 to 10,000 who were killed for the faith during these persecutions. In August, 2014, Pope Francis beatified another 124 Korean martyrs. May they all inspire us as well as the people of Korea https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Korean Martyrs.

Then on Saturday, September 23, we have the Me-

morial of <u>St. Pius of Pietrelcina</u>, <u>O.F.M. Cap</u>, popularly known by the Italian title and name, Padre Pio. He is one of the most famous saints of the 20th Century, zealous in hearing confessions and



encouraging toward penitents, reputed to work miracle during his lifetime, and a recipient of the sacred stigmata — the wounds of Christ — early in life. He was concerned for the sick and was instrumental in having a large hospital built on the hillside above his monastery in southern Italy https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Padre_Pio.
