



#### Star of the Sea Women's Retreat



This year's Women's Retreat will explore Bishop Robert Barron's book: "This Is My Body."

### OUR LADY STAR OF THE SEA PARISH

Marblehead, Massachusetts

September 24, 2023 Twenty-fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

"Conduct yourselves in a way worthy of the gospel of Christ" (see Philippians 1:27a). Saint Paul's prayer and best wish is meant for each of us. As we complete our Summer season and begin Autumn, we ask that God be with us and help us live each season worthy of the Gospel of his Son.

"When the first came, they thought they would receive more... they grumbled..." These words from the Gospel this weekend (see Matthew 20:1-16a) tell of the reaction of some early workers, who thought they should receive more than later arrived workers who had seen but a short day. Sometimes we think mostly of the generosity the Landowner showed to the more recent workers, that he would give them a full day's wage. We can, and should, also think of the generosity of the Landowner to the full-day workers, to those very complainers.

The Landowner was, indeed, very generous to them. Even if he had not increased the agreed upon daily wage, he had sent them, time and again, new workers, new help, new company. Many hands make light work, or so the saying goes. The work-day of these complaining workers had been made much different and, by implication, much lighter because of the willingness of the owner to hire more and more coworkers. The owner was very generous to these complaining workers. They had received their agreed upon wage <u>and</u> they had received much help, much company and much improved conditions, though none of that was in their immediate ken nor appreciation.

How often, in our own prayers, we can fall into that same complaining sprit. We perceive what God may have done for others and we wonder why more has not been done for us. We fail to see that often, and again, God may have sent our way various offers of support, many persons to lighten our load, and many opportunities to go about the work of life in a new way, offering real help that comes our way in an unexpected manner. We think so narrowly of ourselves and our expectations that we fail to see how very generous the good God has been time and time again in our direction.

Such happens when we are too full of thoughts about ourselves. The Gospel invites us to focus on the harvest, the work that is to be done. We are asked to take satisfaction in the goodness of what is accomplished, not so much the amount, great or small, of our reward for the same. St. Paul tells us (see 2 Philippians 1:20c-24, 27a) that "for me life is Christ." God has already given us everything that he is and everything that he has in the saving love of his Son Jesus. He invites you to a share in Christ's mission of bringing life and love to this world. All of life is ours in Christ Jesus. As God's thoughts are "above your thoughts" (see Isaiah 55:6-9) so may we pray to gain better perspective of what it is God invites us to accomplish in life, and realize how very generous God is to us each and every day.

Speaking of new workers to be sent in, we are seeking a Parish Office Secretary to assist with our life and work. Effective skills in welcoming parishioners and patiently seeking solutions to various needs are the heart of the service. Principal responsibilities will focus on communications, and include telephone, email, scheduling, Bulletin and website. Strong computer skills in MS Office and an ability for multi-tasking are essential for the work to be shared. Please call or email me, as noted above, if you can help.



#### Comments from Deacon Joe

#### Star of the Sea

The title Star of the Sea is based on an early interpretation of the meaning of the name Mary. When the idea caught on that Mary's name means "Star of the Sea," devotion arose for her as a guide for mariners, and then more generally as a guide for Chris-

tians showing us the way to heaven. The example of her life models how we should live, thus pointing us toward Jesus.

September 27 seems to be generally considered to be the "feast day" of Our Lady Star of the Sea (although it is outranked by the memorial of St. Vincent de Paul). This week we celebrate the Feast of the Archangels

Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael on September 29. In scripture Michael is seen as protecting God's people, Gabriel brings word of the future birth of Jesus to Mary and to Joseph, and Raphael is a guide to Tobiah on his way to marry Sarah and the

Formerly this was just the Feast of St. Michael, and it was known as Michaelmas (pronounced micklemas),

and in England it was the beginning of terms of court and university. Our Supreme Court's opening of its term on the first Monday of October, shortly after Michaelmas, is a vestige of that custom.

Also this week we have two obligatory memorials, beginning on the 27th with the Memorial of <u>St. Vincent de Paul</u>, Priest. He is known today principally through the St. Vincent de Paul Society which cares for the poor, reflecting one of the saint's major con-



cerns. (It wasn't founded by him but centuries later in furtherance of his concerns,) He founded the Congregation of the Mission (C.M. — the Vincentians) to work among the people of small towns and villages, and co-founded the Daughters of Charity. September 30 is the Memorial of St. Jerome, who translated the Bible into Latin, a version known as the Vulgate. He also wrote extensively on theological topics and is recognized as a Doctor of the Church. He was born in the 340's and died in 420.
