April 2, 2023 Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

We gather this weekend to begin Holy Week, and the celebration of the mysteries of Jesus' passion, death and resurrection. Jesus enters with joy into the Holy City, Jerusalem, to accomplish for us his mission to save. The minute preparations for his entry remind us of the careful setting of all that is necessary for the accomplishment of his mission.

I ask each one of you to consider a fulsome celebration of Holy Week this year. If you regularly join us for the celebrations of the Lord's Supper, the Commemoration of his Holy Death and the first announcement of his Resurrection at the Easter Vigil, then I ask you to reach out and bring someone along with you this year. If you have not recently made these three days of prayer with the Church community, why not do so this year? Maybe you have done one or another. Maybe you haven't attended for years. Maybe this would be your first experience of the Church's most solemn moments of prayer together. Know that the invitation is there, from the Lord, and the best way to answer is "Yes"!

"You have said so." This enigmatic response of Jesus during his passion ordeal is highlighted in Matthew's account, which we pray this year. In key moments with Judas, with the High Priest and with Pilate, Jesus points out that the speaker himself already knows the truth of what is said. The challenge, of course, is whether one accepts and follows that truth or whether one, knowing inwardly what should be done, goes and does something less. As we prepare through Palm Sunday of the Passion to accompany Jesus spiritually through his passions, death and resurrection, we are reminded that our very lives already "say so," already proclaim a truth about God, his love, mercy and forgiveness. We ask for the grace that, by walking this Way with Jesus, we welcome the truth that wells within us like living water, as did the Woman of Samaria. We pray that we welcome that truth that shines as we open our eyes to recognize the wonders of God's mercy, as did the man born blind. We pray that we might come to new life in Jesus, as did Lazarus, his friend, by hearing the Lord call us to come out of the dark tomb of inaction, and be set free from all that ties us down.

Wednesday of this week we have confessions from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. Again, confessions will be offered on Saturday from 11a to 12p and from 2:30 to 3:30 p.m. The Eucharist was given "for the forgiveness of our sins." The Lord offered his life on the cross for the redemption of the human race. There is no better way to make these blessings our own than by going to Jesus in this Sacrament of Penance that is his Easter gift to the Church, and to receive from him, through the ministry of the Church, the absolution of your sins. Come alive in his mercy; come alive in Christ!

One aspect of the Holy Week celebrations which has been largely absent here at Star of the Sea is the Eucharist Watch from the end of the Mass of the Lord's Supper, Thursday evening, until midnight. During that time the Church is open and the faithful are encouraged to spend some time in prayer before the Eucharist in the tabernacle, responding to the Lord's request of his disciples: watch and pray with me, that you not undergo the test. This prayer is, then, for ourselves, our children, families, friends and neighbors. Please consider a visit to the Church during that time, especially if you were not at the Mass, and offer your heart and life with the Lord in the mysteries of his great gifts of love.

May our celebrations of the mysteries of Holy Week draw us closer to God in his love!





Comments from Deacon Joe Holy Week

Holy Week begins today. I especially encourage everybody to attend the special liturgies commemorating the Last Supper, the Crucifixion, and the Resurrection of Jesus on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings. The bulletin also gives information about Masses on other days, opportunities for Confession, and Stations of the Cross as well. The Sacred Triduum is the most sacred time in the year, so try to treat it as particularly special.

A new book is now available in the church. Titled Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist: Unlocking the Secrets of the Last Supper, by Brant Pitré, it delves deeply into what Jewish scripture and tradition can tell us. As the author writes in the Introduction, "By focusing on the Jewish context of Jesus' teachings, ... all of his words come alive in a way that is exciting and powerful. ... [I]t is precisely the Jewish roots of Jesus' words that will ... unlock the secrets of who he was and what he meant when he said to his disciples, 'Take, eat, this is my body.'" I'm sure it can

help you come to a deeper understanding of the Mass and a greater enthusiasm for it. I have begun to read my copy of the book, and I'm very excited about it.

Recent Events On March 25 I attended the Prayer Service for Peace in Ukraine at Christ the King Ukrainian Catholic Church in Forest Hills. Cardinal Seán and the Ukrainian Catholic Archbishop of Philadelphia presided, and both spoke very well of the need for peace and of the importance of defeating Russia's aggression. The Globe carried a story, which should be available on line, as is the Pilot's coverage. Last Sunday, I was at the concert in our church, featuring "The Seven Last Words of Christ" by Theodore Dubois. The performers did very well. Congratulations to all, especially to our Music Director Matt Arnold, who organized it. I'm looking forward to future concerts.

This week we observe Holy Week and the Sacred Triduum.


