

May 28, 2023 Pentecost

Dear Parishioner of Our Lady Star of the Sea,

We celebrate this weekend the Solemnity of Pentecost. We celebrate the "birthday" of our Church community by celebrating what to be "born from above; born again" truly means. We celebrate God's bestowing on us the Holy Spirit, God's own love, as a gift in our lives, bringing us into the very live and life of God in and through Jesus, for the sake of the world.

Meeting the disciples in the locked room of their fear and uncertainty (see John 20:19-23), Jesus enjoins them to "Receive the Holy Spirit!" The gift of this Spirit alone quells fear at its root. The gift of the Spirit unlocks hearts. The gift reopens communication and relationship with God and with one another. By receiving this Gift of God from on high, the disciples are transformed and sent forth. They speak in a new way. They begin to work with Jesus, establishing God's new creation. They begin to experience what it means to be "born from above."

The prime work of the Holy Spirit is the living, preaching and realization of God's mercy through the forgiveness of sins. When fear is set aside in favor of the Gift of the Holy Spirit, we learn to speak the language of God's heart. God so loved the world, Saint John tells us, that he sent his Son as our Savior, not to condemn but to save and to raise up. Reflecting that twofold mission, Jesus charges his disciples to forgive and to retain others' sin. Note the conjunction "and" and not "or." He sends us with the mission to forgive and to retain! We are to forgive in the ways that Jesus did for the Apostles: with peace, with joy, readily and from the heart. And we are to "retain" sins. This does not mean to hold on to sins or to past hurts or failures. That was the work of fear, that must be definitively left dead behind. We are to actively work to retain sin. That is, we hold back the earthly, or temporal, damage that sin brings about in the world, in relationship and in ourselves. Jesus forgave sinners from the heights of his cross. Jesus actively retains and removes the bad consequences of those sins from working further wreck in the context of our lives and our world through the gift of the Holy Spirit. By attending to Christ's command to love one another as he has loved us we follow in his ways. Through the gift of the Holy Spirit, Jesus makes manifest how we go forth into the world. We go with good news of forgiveness and we actively build a new and better way of life by speaking to the heart all that the heart longs to hear.

This weekend marks Memorial Day 2023. The annual observances include the town's Monday programs at Memorial Square and Waterside Cemetery, as well as a prayer service and Veterans' Salute to be held today, Sunday, at 1:00 p.m. at Star of the Sea Cemetery. We pray for all our fallen military, in whose honor the Country pauses in prayer and recognition. We pray, too, for loved ones and friends who have died. All are welcome.

You and I, as disciples of the Lord, receive from the Lord the gift of the Holy Spirit. We, too, are sent with the Good News of Jesus' victory over sin and death to be announced to the world. We know that the world around us has need of such good news. As followers of Christ, we have the chance to speak to the heart of wounded humanity. But first, we ourselves need renewal. Be a living sign of New Life, new birth from above. Then be on a mission that brings healing and peace where it is most needed.

Wishing each and every Disciple of the Lord a happy Pentecost, Happy Birthday for our Church and your own rebirth in the joy of God's forgiving love, I am

Comments from Deacon Joe Pentecost/Ordinary Time

Today, Pentecost, is the last day of Eastertide. Ordinary Time begins on Monday. Still, we continue to celebrate Easter all year in a way. After all, Sunday is the Christian "sabbath" because it was on a Sunday that Jesus rose from the dead, and every Sunday we gather at Mass to celebrate the Resurrection. Furthermore, as Pope Francis reminds us in Desiderio Desideravi, at every Mass, even on weekdays, the Good Friday-Easter event takes place before our eyes. But during Ordinary Time we also look at Jesus' entire earthly ministry — his teachings and his miracles. Let's try to be aware from week to week between now and Advent that the gospel readings we hear aren't isolated events but part of Jesus' ongoing ministry preparing people — now including us — to carry on spreading God's kingdom after his saving work is completed. We must be formed as disciples just as his original hearers were.

It won't feel much like Ordinary Time at Sunday Mass for a couple of weeks because we'll be celebrating solemnities on June 4 and 11, but weekday Mass-goers will start seeing green vestments on Tuesday. Before Lent started we were in the seventh week in Ordinary Time. This will be the eighth week. The ninth and tenth Sundays in Ordinary Time have Solemnities preempting their Masses, but on June 18 we'll be back to Ordinary Time Masses on Sundays as well.

Memorial Day is probably my favorite civic holiday. Honoring those who gave their lives in military service to our country is a debt we owe to them, and I believe our town fulfills the obligation very well with our parade and the ceremonies at Memorial Park and at Waterside Cemetery. When I was a selectman, I considered it a great honor to march in the parade, and I encourage you to be present for at least some part of the observances. https://www.marblehead.org/home/news/memorial-dayweekend-events-0


